TODAY IS WEEK 5 PROGRAM

PORT HUNTER ZONE COMBINED EVENT AT MALLABULA SPORTS COMPLEX

Today is your last chance to enter next Sunday's Combined Event which begins at 9:30. **See the noticeboard for the program of events. The events are announced** and you get to sit, relax and cheer for your athletes if you don't have a duty. Only athletes and officials are allowed onto the field. Depending on the number of athletes we have attending, we may be able to have one of our RTAC marquees for athletes and parents to shelter under. There will be a BBQ and canteen operating. The sporting complex has a pool, footy field and skate ramps if you want to take advantage of them when you finish. See Barbara to enter. **There is a lucky draw of \$75 vouchers – 2 for boys and 2 for girls.** It's also a good opportunity to check out the field that you will be using again for the Zone Championships 2 weeks later. So far we have 14 of our athletes competing.

When you turn into the complex from Lemon Tree Passage Rd, make an immediate right turn past the pool and follow the track around to the far side. There is a large car park for the athletics field.

PORT HUNTER ZONE CHAMPIONSHIPS 15 and 16 NOVEMBER

This is also at Mallabula Sports Complex. You have the choice of doing just Saturday or Sunday events or some on both days. Athletes 7's to 12's can choose 4 events and 13's to U20 can do 6 events. As with the Combined event, only athletes and Officials can go onto the field. The events are on the noticeboard and on a photocopied page on the verandah table. Entries are online and close next Saturday – see the QR code also on the noticeboard and table. Don't forget that a \$50 per athlete refundable deposit must be paid to Barbara when you enter. If you do your assigned duty, you can collect your deposit at our next Centre meet.

7's who place in a final will be presented with medals. 8's to U20's can qualify for the Region Championships at Maitland on Friday 13 to Sunday 15 February.

WHAT ARE CENTRE CHAMPIONSHIPS?

Centre Championships consist of 2 Rounds of competition, this season to be held on **Saturday 22 Nov and TBD in February.** Each Round consists of 5 events. Points are awarded for achievement - the better the result, the greater the points. A combined event point score is used. Total points earned over the 2 Rounds will determine the Sub-Junior (6's - 8's), Junior (9's & 10's), Sub-Senior (11's & 12's), Senior 13's - 15's), 17's - U20, Open; and Masters Champions for which trophies will be awarded at **Presentation Day.**
